What to see & do on the South Coast

PORTSMOUTH is a city very much associated with the sea and has plenty to keep the whole family entertained. With miles of waterfront, Portsmouth has a great mix of history, heritage, shopping and restaurants and a visit to the Spinnaker Tower, is not to be missed. Portsmouth's Historic Dockyard has historic ships the Mary Rose, HMS Victory and HMS Warrior. **SHORT TRIPS** are ideal for children. There are excellent transport links for your return journey.

SWANAGE is a compact, friendly resort, picturesquely set in a broad, gently curving bay. Advertised fares include an admission charge of £17.50, which is a donation, and the appropriate sailing fare. The donation means the charity is able to claim an additional £4.38 from HMRC by way of Gift Aid.

If you are a taxpayer and agree to WSN claiming Gift Aid on your donation then in the event of a cancellation, the first £17.50 of your fare will be available to use against a future sailing. The balance of your fare is refundable on request or can be used as a credit for a future sailing.

A limited number of sailing only fares are available, these should be purchased in advance and can only be experienced in the lower bar.
