## What to see & do on the BRISTOL CHANNEL

**ILFRACOMBE** Visit this idyllic seaside town situated on the North Devon coast of Exmoor. A popular holiday destination, Ilfracombe offers plenty of family entertainment and the famous Tunnel Beaches. A five minute walk from the pier takes you to the main streets where various shops, restaurants, pubs and cafes.

**LUNDY ISLAND** Take a trip to the national trust island which lies off the coast of North Devon on the edge of the Atlantic Ocean. The waters surrounding the island are England's only statutory Nature Reserve, with a large variety of birds and sea life. Once on the island you can visit the church, shop and the Marisco Tavern for refreshments.

**STEAM TRAIN & MINEHEAD** Join the West Somerset Railway at Minehead for a nostalgic 20 mile steam train trip to Bishops Lydeard. Travel through the rolling Quantock hills, unspoilt villages and farms nestling in leafy lanes, the cliffs and coast of the Bristol Channel.

**WELSH MOUNTAINS by STEAM TRAIN** The former Brecon & Merthyr junction railway takes you through beautiful scenery into Beacons National Park along the full length of the Taf Fechan Reservoir to Dol-y-Gaer. At Pontsticill you can visit the cafe, admire the views and go for a ramble along the reservoir.
